Extended Schools Programme – Community Cohesion / Big Society

- Established ecumenical charity in 1996
- Employed first worker in 1997 with a focus on work in primary schools
- Developed a 'dance band' ministry (Overtone) to establish work in secondary schools in 2000
- Team now grown to 5 full-time and 3 parttime staff and 3 gap year students as a part of our trainee schools worker programme



# Strategy...

#### **Schools:**

- Offering Christian teaching programmes within the RE, PSHE and Citizenship curriculum
- Promoting a positive relational role in school communities through regular clubs, events and through mentoring pupils



# Strategy...

#### **Churches:**

- 'Joined up' work across York through city-wide Youth and Children's services/events and network groups
- Equipping and resourcing churches in their Youth and Children's work (training programmes)
- Providing opportunities for local volunteers to serve in their local schools
- Supporting church youth and children's workers



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### What we do in York...

#### In York there are:

- 70 schools
- with over 24,000 children and young people

### With your help YoYo regularly reaches out to:

- around 3/4 of the schools
- 15,000 of their pupils

YoYo aims to give every child and young person in York the chance to hear and respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ through clear, relevant and regular communication in schools and at events.

Open the Book is a primary school assembly scheme which is running in a number of schools around York. It's a great way for children to learn the basic Bible stories from Old and New Testaments.



#### How we serve York's churches

Encouraging, equipping and supporting churches in their work with children and young people...



Even the best Sunday School and Youth work touches only a small percentage of children...

39% of churches have no under 11s

49% of churches have no 11-14s

59% of churches have no 15-18s

But all the children have to go to school!

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#### **Service and Nurture**

# **Primary:**

- Key teaching programmes (*It's Your...*) based around Christian festivals, transition work, bible lessons and heritage trails
- Open the Book A National Scheme of Bible based assemblies led by local volunteers
- Kids Rock: Christian lunch-time and after schools clubs – resourcing volunteers to work in school



#### **Primary – since September**

- 84 Assemblies
- Over 126 lessons
- Bookings from 6 new schools (we are now working in 45 primary schools)
- 3 weeks of our new *It's Your City* Christian Heritage programme. Keeping up to date with new opportunities within education
- Weekly clubs (Kids Rock) and assembly programmes (OTB) running in 18 schools



#### **Service and Nurture**

# Secondary:

- Focus Weeks teaching RE, PSHE and Citizenship across all years and leading whole school collective worship.
- Rock Solid Christian lunch-time and after school clubs – resourcing churches to work in schools
- Christian Unions supporting Christians in schools to be a light in their school community



#### Secondary – since September

- 12 Focus weeks
- 257 KS3/4 lessons reaching approx 6000 pupils
- Assemblies reaching approx 1700 pupils
- New developments into KS5 with 26 A-level lessons taught this year.
- Weekly clubs (Rock Solids) and/or CU's in 11 schools
